Additional learning supports and resources are neatly organized in the online Canvas course. With each drawing assignment we are exposed to the traditional aspects of the techniques and concepts, but global art traditions are also incorporated when applicable or if student interest leans in that direction. This occurs while meeting the shared objectives for a Drawing I class. The best part of the class was the way each person was guided to learn and improve. Final portfolios highlight the exceptional progress of each person and Sudeshna's feedback and support is critical in the growth and learning process. There was a real classroom community established by Sudeshna. In class we talked to one another and having a discussion board space called the virtual cafe gave us room to talk, share art, and communicate in a more informal way. On several occasions the Albuquerque students planned outdoor drawing meetings to practice. This occurred because Sudeshna cultivated a true environment of collegiality. I live in Albuquerque so this course teaching modality worked for me, especially because Sudeshna goes above and beyond to make each component, both the synchronous zoom meetings and the canvas aspects, interactive.
